## BINGO


Bingo is a game of chance that probably first started in Italy. In 1530, a national weekly lottery appeared on the market, and it is still held today. Two hundred and fifty years later, people in academic circles in France started playing a game that was almost the same as the Bingo game that is now played around the world.

Bingo can be played by a lot of players at the same time. Each player has a small piece of paper with five rows and five columns. The spaces are written with numbers from 1 to 75. Somebody then calls out numbers that he or she chooses randomly. If a player has one of those numbers, he or she draws a dot on that number. If a player gets a line of five dots, he or she shouts out "Bingo!" to let everybody know. After a line, players may have to get four corners or get all the dots on the whole card to win a prize or money.

Because Bingo is a way to gamble, some people can even lose a lot of money from it. They may play a dozen or more cards at the same time in the hope of winning big. Some people may even put good luck dolls around their cards. However, when Bingo is played just for fun, it is an interesting game for all.

The game is so popular that the word "bingo" has entered the English language. If you are very happy about something or your friend says something that you agree with, you can say "Bingo!"

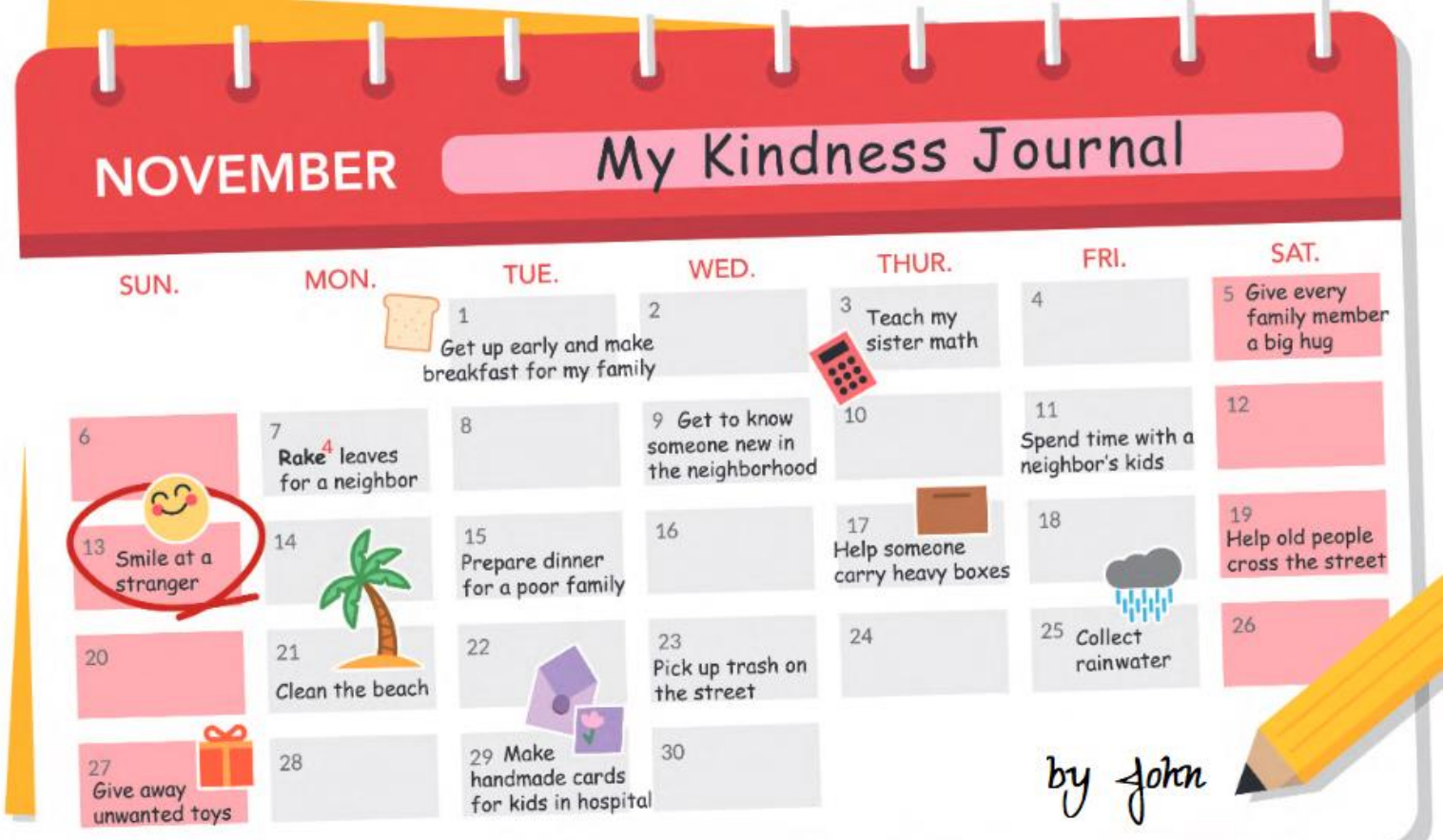
