A manga artist must draw well and be able to come up with interesting stories. Both of them take a lot of time to work on. Besides, it's important to read a lot of manga because you can learn how to create a manga and prepare for your own work.


Most of the artists never get any formal training. Some artists write their own stories, but there are also those who work together with famous artists first. To publish your own manga, some simply give their works to publishers in the hope of getting good news; others enter manga competitions to catch publishers' eyes. 
